UKRAINIAN EASTER

- Pysanky (hand-decorated eggs with symbolic patterns)
- Krashanky (Boiled eggs dyed in vibrant colors)
- Kovbasa (Homemade sausage made of pork and spices, often smoked or baked)

Paska. (A sweet, rich Easter bread decorated with symbolic patterns)



UKRAINIAN CHRISTMAS

- Kutia (a ceremonial dish made from wheat grains, honey, poppy seeds, and nuts.)
- Borscht (a vibrant beetroot soup filled with hearty vegetables and earthy flavours. Prepared without meat for the occasion.)
- Holubtsi (Tender cabbage rolls stuffed with rice and vegetables simmered in a light tomato sauce.)
- Pampushky (Fluffy buns, served plain or with garlic oil. These are a delightful accompaniment to the main meal.)
- Makivnyk (A poppy seed roll dessert, made with a soft, sweet dough and filled generously with a poppy seed paste.)

MACEDONIAN EASTER

Boiled red dyed eggs

- Green salad (lettuce, cucumbers, tomatoes and mayonnaise)
- Lamb or pork mixed with roasted potatoes and carrots
- Kozunak (sweet yeast dough mixed with raisins or walnut filling)



MACEDONIAN CHRISTMAS

- Mayonnaise salad (mayonnaise, pickles, salami, cheese, eggs, potatoes, carrots, peas, ham)
- Baked beans (bean, onions, red and black pepper, salt and parsley)
- Charcuterie board (eggs, olives, cheese, chicken, cucumber, salami)
- Embi (dark chocolate, cornflakes, honey)
