NOTE ON THE ITALIAN HIGHER EDUCATION, CREDIT AND GRADING SYSTEM

Since 1999 (Ministerial Decree no. 509/99), Italian University system has been fully reformed so as to meet the objectives of the **"Bologna process"**. It is organized in **3 cycles**: the 1st cycle academic degree ("Laurea" - Bachelor degree) grants access to the 2nd cycle academic degree ("Laurea Magistrale" - Master degree), which gives access to the 3rd cycle doctoral programmes resulting in the PhD degree (Dottorato di Ricerca). The [European Credit Transfer System](#) (ECTS) is used by Italian Universities to evaluate and measure the workload of single courses as well as of entire qualifications. ECTS credits represent the total student workload (class time, individual study, exam preparation, practical work, etc.) required to complete a course/module/degree. According to Italian legislation, **one ECTS/ CFU credit is equivalent to 25 hours**.

Exams are graded using a grading scale of 30, where 18 is the minimum passing grade and 30 cum laude the highest grade.
