

Howest grade on /20	Definition
16/20 and more	EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor error The student has an exceptionally high command of the pursued competence(s)
14/20 & 15/20	VERY GOOD – above the average standard but with some errors The student has a very good command of the pursued competence(s) and distinguishes him/herself
12/20 & 13/20	GOOD – generally sound work with a number of notable errors The student has a good command of the pursued competence(s)
11/20	SATISFACTORY – fair but with significant shortcomings
10/20	10/20 is the PASS SCORE SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria The student has acquired sufficient command of the pursued competence(s) in order to function and/or continue studying
7/20 & 8/20 & 9/20	FAIL – some work required before the credit can be awarded The student has not yet acquired sufficient command of the pursued competences in order to function and/or continue studying
6/20 and less	FAIL – considerable further work is required The student has not at all acquired sufficient command of the pursued competences
